Two of the biggest health concerns facing Delaware's workforce, diabetes and obesity, are major cost drivers for employers in our community and nationwide.

- Among U.S. adults, 37 million have diabetes and 96 million have prediabetes, at an annual combined cost of \$403 billion.¹
- Among Delaware adults, 12% have diabetes and 13% have prediabetes, at an annual cost of \$1.1 billion.²
- The reported obesity rate for adults for U.S. and Delaware adults is 34%.³ The nationwide direct medical cost of obesity is \$173 billion.⁴

Promoting a workforce culture to support healthy lifestyles is vital in addressing these conditions.
